CURBSIDE PICKUP REMINDERS

Alternate accessible formats available on request.



Set Out Time: Place all waste and recycling at the curb by 7 a.m. on collection day. Pickup times can vary due to holidays, construction, traffic delays, weather, staffing, or equipment breakdowns.



Bin Guidelines: Keep recyclables loose in a blue bin no larger than 2 feet tall by 18 inches wide. Recyclables should not be bagged or placed in a cart. Always break down carborad. No recycling separation is needed.



Weight Limits: Ensure that each waste bag or recycling bin weighs no more than 40 lbs to help operators safely lift items into the truck.



Missed Pickups: Pickup delays or missed collections can occur for many reasons. Check our website and social media pages for updates, and report all missed pickups through Contact GB.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Single use batteries can be taken to the Home Depot in Owen Sound at no charge. All hazardous Waste Materials can be taken to the Owen Sound Public Works building during designated HHW Days:

Choose digital options for books, magazines, and subscriptions, and embrace a simpler lifestyle by focusing on what truly adds value.
